The Chick Mission is a nonprofit organization fiercely dedicated to providing fertility preservation for women battling cancer. Founder Amanda Rice started The Chick Mission after battling cancer three times before her 40th birthday; she was also forced to fight her insurance provider who refused to cover the \$20,000+ cost of egg freezing because she wasn't infertile "yet," even though she about to undergo cancer treatment that would jeopardize her fertility.

Born out of her own frustration and concern for other women's fertility futures, The Chick Mission provides Hope Grants to newly diagnosed cancer patients that fully cover the cost of access to fertility preservation ahead of life-saving cancer treatment. Simultaneously, The Chick Mission increases awareness and tackles the issue proactively through education and advocacy.
