



NOTE-WRITING TIPS & TEMPLATE

Hope Grant recipients are young women newly diagnosed with cancer whose fertility preservation treatment is paid for by The Chick Mission. These women are coming to terms with a cancer diagnosis and preparing to undergo life-saving treatment, including chemotherapy, radiation, and surgery.

Beyond financial support, we do everything we can to ensure women facing some of their darkest days are reminded of their strength and have hope for their future.

Ahead of treatment, The Chick Mission mails out a care package to each Hope Grant recipient. The note(s) you write will be included in our next care packages, providing a reminder to Hope Grant recipients that they have a *flock* rallying behind them every step of the way.

HOW TO: WRITE A HEARTFELT AND UPLIFTING NOTE TO A HOPE GRANT RECIPIENT!

SELECT generally appealing stationary (*non-denominational OR seasonal*)

WRITE a warm message of encouragement and support with words of empowerment, resilience, hope, and kind wishes for their future

SHARE what inspires you, what helps you feel empowered during challenging times, what it means to support other “chicks” in your “flock,” general words of support

DO NOT SHARE anything negative, frightening, or discouraging; medical advice or suggestions; any of your personal contact information

SIGN the card with your first name **ONLY** or as “a member of The Chick Mission flock”
